

The EADB Director General Paid a Curtsey Call to the MINAFFET

On August 20, 2009, Madam Vivienne Yeda Apopo, Director General of the East African Development Bank, paid a curtsey call to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation. Madam Vivienne was received by Ambassador MUNYAKAYANZA Eugène, Permanent Secretary in MINAFFET.
