

Abdelkader AZARIA, Ambassador of Algeria bid farewell to the Foreign Affairs Minister

On October 1, 2009 H.E Abdelkader Azaria, Ambassador of the People Democratic Republic of Algeria met Hon. Rosemary Museminali, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation to bid farewell as his tour of duty is ending. Amb. Azaria took this opportunity to discuss with the Minister issues related to the economic and financial reform the Algerian Government is undertaking in order to promote better transparency in financial transactions conducted by foreign firms. He also exposed to the Minister the Algerian position on the Middle East issue, reaffirming the support two-State-solution pushed by the US President Barack Obama and opposing to the continued illegal settlement in the Palestinian territory.

The Algerian Ambassador also briefed the Minister on the current status of the relation between Algeria and Morocco and the question of Western Sahara.

Minister agreed and expressed her support to the ongoing reform undertaken by Algerian Government in the economic and financial sector. She also reaffirmed the Rwandan position on the Middle East issue, in line with the two-State-solution approach. On the Western Sahara issue, the Minister told the Ambassador that Rwanda was following the African Union position, recognizing the right of self determination.

Amb. Abdelkader Azaria pledged to be a good will ambassador of Rwanda in Algeria. He was accredited to Rwanda with residence in Kampala, Uganda.
